

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION



If you have a child who will turn 5 on or before **August 1, 2019**, your child is eligible to attend kindergarten during the 2019-2020 school year. Please join us to let us know your child will be coming to Kindergarten.

Monday and Thursday we will stay open until 6:00 p.m.

You may also register at any of the schools Kindercamps.

Parents may register for any school on any date. You may download the forms and complete them and drop them off, pick up the forms and take them with you to return them later, or fill them out when you come by the office. What to Bring:

- Valid Kentucky Immunization Certificate
- Copy of Social Security Card
- Official Birth Certificate
- School Physical
- Professional Eye Exam
- Dental Exam

If you do not have all items on the dates of registration, please come anyway. Bring what you have and take care of the other items before school starts in August.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

- ◆ You **do not have to bring your child** with you to registration.
- ◆ If your child currently attends preschool at Clay City Elementary, Bowen Elementary, or Stanton Elementary, papers will be sent home to register and you are not required to attend any registration date.
- ◆ If your child currently attends the Head Start Building in Clay City, you **MUST** register for kindergarten but we will have the required documents from Head Start.
- ◆ In order to register your child, we will need your picture identification and any custody or legal documents you have in regards to the child you are enrolling. Only legal guardians may enroll a child in school.
